1 New & Improved

These changes add new features or improve the functionality of existing ones:

- Desktop: allow ldap filter to be empty. (ICE-9121)
- ICE Desktop - Add support for LDAP search filter field. (ICE-9007)

2 Fixes

These issues have been resolved in this version of the product:

- Desktop : PTT latches on doing PTT using hotkey “transmit on selected channels”. Discovered in 2.1.0. (ICE-6354)

3 Known Issues

These are issues known to exist in the product:

3.0.1 Enabling or disabling the Instant Replay feature in ICE Desktop may not take effect until the application is restarted. (ICE-8216)

3.0.1.1 Workaround Quit and re-open the ICE Desktop application whenever changes to the the Instant Replay settings are made.

3.0.2 On Windows, a channel utilizing multicast networking may not display a warning when multicast is unavailable. (ICE-8134)

3.0.2.1 Conditions This condition affects channels that are utilizing IGMP multicast on a Windows PC where the underlying network interface does not support multicast traffic. The system should display a warning indicating that the channel is disconnected, but does not.

3.0.2.2 Workaround Administrators intending to use IGMP multicast for channel communications should assure that the device selection made under Settings, General, Network Interface supports multicast.

3.0.3 The “Reset App Data and Restart” command from the Troubleshooting menu quits but does not re-open ICE Desktop on Windows. (ICE-6511)

3.0.3.1 Conditions On certain Windows systems, programmatically restarting ICE Desktop from within the application (i.e., from Help->Troubleshooting->Reset App Data and Restart) results in the application window disappearing and not returning. Certain child processes associated with ICE Desktop may not exit cleanly and will be visible as running processes in the Windows Task Manager.

3.0.3.2 Workaround Use the Windows Task Manager to forcibly quit any process containing the name “ICE Desktop”. Then, re-open the application.

3.0.4 A licensed copy of ICE Desktop may indicate that it is unlicensed when being launched by double-clicking a Mission file. (ICE-6408)

3.0.4.1 Conditions This occurs only when ICE Desktop is launched in response to opening a Mission file. The user will be limited to three seconds transmit time.

3.0.4.2 Workaround Exit the application and re-open it directly.
