3 Known Issues

These are issues known to exist in the product:

3.0.1 Live rendering of people search results reflect the prior search term, rather than the new one, as long as that new search term is only 1-2 characters long. Once the new search term reaches 3 characters in length, the live rendered results reflect the new term. (ICE-14735)

3.0.1.1 Conditions This occurs when performing a people search immediately after a prior search, where the prior search term was removed via deletion, rather than via selecting the search refresh button.

3.0.1.2 Workaround Select the search refresh button prior to making people searches.

3.0.2 When adding/removing users to/from a user group, those changes are not automatically applied to channels assigned to that user group. (ICE-14724)

3.0.2.1 Workaround Restart and re-login to the application.

3.0.3 On some keyboards, the Ctrl+Right and Alt+Right key combinations may not work for hotkeys configured in ICE Desktop. (ICE-9735)

3.0.3.1 Conditions Some keyboards may incorrectly report key press events for Ctrl+Right and Alt+Right (that is, pressing the “Control” or “Alt” key appearing on the right-hand side of the keyboard) when using Microsoft Windows 10.

3.0.3.2 Workaround Use other keys for hot key functionality, for example, use the Control and Alt keys on the left side of the keyboard when defining hotkeys.

3.0.4 Workflow Event Trigger is not triggering any Action on Date/Time Event type when Repeat option is set to NEVER. (ICE-9173)

3.0.5 For Windows PCs, a channel utilizing multicast networking may not display a warning when multicast is unavailable. (ICE-8134)

3.0.5.1 Conditions This condition affects channels that are utilizing IGMP multicast on a Windows PC where the underlying network interface does not support multicast traffic. The system should display a warning indicating that the channel is disconnected, but does not.

3.0.5.2 Workaround Administrators intending to use IGMP multicast for channel communications should assure that the device selection made under Settings > General > Network Interface supports multicast.

3.0.6 People and channel lists do not display all entities when 1000+ users or 200+ channels are created in bulk. (ICE-8130)
